1. **Apologies** None
2. **Minutes of the Previous Meeting** It was **resolved** that the minutes of the previous meeting be signed as a true record.
3. **Declarations of Interest**
Cllr Bleasdale and Cllr Millar declared an interest in all planning applications as members or substitute members of the Borough Council planning committee and a conflict of interest therefore arose.
4. **POLICE** Police matters had been dealt with prior to the Council meeting.
5. **Reports from District/County Councillors**
 - (a) Cllr Bleasdale reported that a public meeting was being held at Dalton Cricket Club for members of the public to discuss any matters arising from recent roadworks.
 - (b) Barrow BC Executive Committee Cllr Millar reported that Phil Huck had addressed the Executive Committee with recommendations for dissolving the DDP. Phil Huck will attend the next Town Council meeting to discuss the options if he is available on that date.
6. **Matters Arising**
 - (a) Councillors Surgery – Cllr Millar reported that there had been one member of the public attending the recent surgery which was a housing issue that the Borough Council were already dealing with. Next surgery will be held on Saturday 28th November 2009. Cllr Thurlow and Cllr Doughty will attend.
 - (b) Retirement of Dowdales Head. – To be included on the next agenda.
 - (c) Highways – There was nothing to report at the moment, however it was agreed that a letter of thanks be sent to the Chair of the Local Area Committee for Highways staff for making an excellent job of the improvements to the surfacing in Market Street and Tudor Square.
7. **Correspondence**
 - (a) Cumbria County Council – Notification of new operator of Ambleside via Newby Bridge and Windermere.
 - (b) Lancashire Economic Partnership – Prospectus for the Morecambe Bay and Duddon Programme
 - (c) BT Adopt a Kiosk Scheme – BT has now extended the adopt a kiosk scheme, the only red kiosk available in this area for adoption is located in Newton Village. A representation from a resident of Newton Village had approached the Council and asked for the kiosk to be adopted. Following

discussion it was agreed that the Town Council adopt the kiosk. The Town Clerk is to proceed with the application and report back to Council.

8. **Funding and Partnership with BAE Systems**
Planters are still ongoing but will be completed soon. Graduates are attending the youth club which has started on a Monday evening between 5-7pm.
9. **Christmas Illuminations** P & L Lighting have now confirmed that they can supply lights for Market Place at a cost of £890 excl vat. Small Tree lights have now been ordered from Festive Lighting at a cost of 2249.40 incl vat. 60 Leads for connection will also be required which P & L will make up. Councillors agreed purchase.

11. **Gateway Signage** Councillor Doughty has been looking at Gateway signage with a view to advertising events, notices would include sliding boards which would be removable. Councillor Doughty is to look at designs, costs and obtain an artists impression and report back Council so a decision can be made.
